



2017 Ben Ann Tomayko Neighbor of the Year Award recognizes an individual who demonstrates a high level of support to an individual neighborhood, a group of neighborhoods, or neighbors throughout Fort Worth. Nominees may be officers or members of League-member neighborhood or homeowner associations. Their spirit of volunteerism may be recognized for work on a single, significant project, a single year, or long-term service to neighborhood(s). The award is given in memory of the late Ben Ann Tomayko, a co-founder of the Fort Worth League of Neighborhoods and longtime Fort Worth neighborhood advocate.

The nomination application is limited to the page of contact information plus text documentation not to exceed 5 pages plus 5 pages of attachments (optional) illustrating the service of the nominee.

Nominations are open to Fort Worth League of Neighborhoods members only, and the winner is selected and presented by the Fort Worth League of Neighborhoods.
